Sunday 15th November 2026 - At Sea

A day at sea today, so why not relax in the Atlantis Spa or by the pool, or take part in one of the various activities on board.

Monday 16th November 2026 - Istanbul, Turkey

Situated in north-western Turkey, Istanbul is seen as the place where east meets west, with a cultural diversity stretching back over centuries. Historically known as both Byzantine and Constantinople, it has seen many ancient empires. Skyscrapers sit alongside traditional and historical structures, such as the Blue Mosque – an iconic landmark in the city, and a fully functioning religious site. We enjoy an overnight stay in Istanbul and a chance to watch the sunset and breathtaking views over the skyline.

Tuesday 17th November 2026 - Istanbul, Turkey

Wake up to the sunrise over the Bosphorus and another day to explore Istanbul. Maybe experience shopping in the Grand Bazaar, the renowned maze of souqs, located under a beautifully decorated ceiling, and haggle over jewellery, spices and ceramics, in its bustling alleys, with rich aromas and historic charm.

Wednesday 18th November 2026 - At Sea

Enjoy another day at sea. Take a look at the 'Daily Times' to see what activities are happening around the ship.

Thursday 19th November 2026 - Piraeus (for Athens), Greece

Having long served as the gateway to the Ancient city of Athens, Piraeus has an attractive marina area. However it is generally used to visit Athens, whose important landmarks include the Acropolis, the hilltop citadel overlooking the city, also home to the Parthenon Temple and the Temple of Zeus. Close by is the Panathenaic Stadium, originally built as a racetrack in 330 BC, but has been completely rebuilt and is open to the public. Later travel to Athens airport for the flight back to the UK and make our way home to Staffordshire, with memories of a fantastic cruise.

Mobility Information

Disabled access cabins can be requested at time of booking but are not guaranteed. On all cruises you must be able to board and disembark the ship unaided, the ship cannot assist due to liability. Balmoral is perfect for scenic cruising. Guests on board have plenty of space in which to relax including the alfresco Poolside restaurant and Marquee Bar.

Balmoral has several restaurant options, including the main restaurant Ballindalloch, The Grill for speciality dining and Palms Café for relaxed dining.
